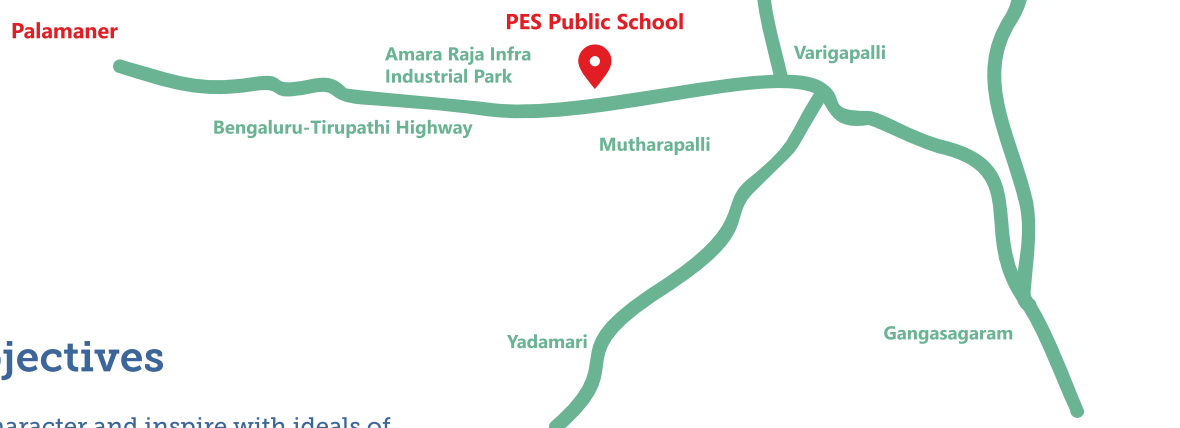
The school is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), New Delhi, and Andhra Pradesh State Educational Department.

PES PUBLIC SCHOOL is located on the outskirts of Chittoor town, next to Amar Raja Growth Corridor, Chittoor District, Andhra Pradesh, on the Chittoor-Bangalore National Highway. On a stretch of five acres of land, the sprawling campus has lush green surroundings. The school has impressive buildings with modern facilities and sophisticated equipment. The school location is accessible by all modes of transport from any part of the country. The campus is just 15 minutes drive from the railway station and the bus stand. The built up area of the School Block is 16,030 sq.ft. with a play ground area of 8,000 sq.ft.

Courses of Studies

Kindergarten

Primary Level: Classes I to V

Middle Level: Classes VI to VIII

Secondary Level: Classes IX & X

Eligibility

Children completing 3 years and six months as on 1st June of the academic year are eligible to seek admission for LKG. The school will admit pupils to classes from LKG to Std IX and Std XI for the academic year 2018-2019, from all recognized schools following State or Central syllabus on the basis of Entrance Test and on submission of required documents like original Birth Certificate, Transfer Certificate, Conduct Certificate and Mark Sheet.

Admission Procedure

Admission in PES PUBLIC SCHOOL is open to all categories of students irrespective of caste, creed, colour or religion.

Students from English medium schools with good academic performance and inclination to study are eligible to apply.

On Registration, candidates - should appear for a written entrance test in the following subjects - Maths, Science, Social Science, English, Telugu and Hindi.

Written Test and Interview of students are conducted on the day of entrance test. It is mandatory that parents should accompany their ward(s) for Entrance Test as well as for interview.

On the basis of the performance in the written test and interview and considering all other General & Specific Criteria, the Merit List of provisionally selected candidates will be prepared and put up on the School Notice Board.

Applicants selected should confirm their admission within the stipulated date, remit the fee, submit the duly completed declaration form and other essential documents.



Academic Year

The academic year is scheduled from April to March with vacation during the month of May. The School re-opens in 1st week of June. The School remains open on all days except Sundays, Second Saturdays and Government declared holidays.

The Academic Year consists of two terms:

First Term	April to September
Second Term	October to March

School Timings

Class Activities are scheduled from Monday to Saturday. Each day is divided into two sessions: Morning and Afternoon.

Note: Students should be present in their class rooms before 8:30 am. If, delayed due to the reason approved by the parent or warden, the student should bring a "Letter of Explanation" from the parent or warden and enter the class with the permission of the Principal.



Fee Details

Fee particulars can be collected from the office as it varies from class to class.

Medical Examination

All the students will undergo a free medical examination annually, by a panel of expert doctors.



Hostel Facilities

In order to facilitate the stay of the Students, an excellent Residential Accommodation is provided to both boys and girls in separate Hostel Blocks which are spacious and well furnished. The Hostel offers a comfortable living environment under the Supervision of Male Wardens for boys and Lady Wardens for girls. The security arrangements are monitored and a full time counselor caters to the needs of the Students. The Hostel Admission Form, Medical Form and other details are available In the School.

General Rules and Information

Hostel Students must be present on the Campus on the previous day of the School re-opening day. Students should not bring any costly articles or keep money with them.

No cell phone is permitted.

Students are responsible for their own belongings.

All students should converse in English on the school campus.

Students must keep themselves neat and tidy.

Students should keep their rooms and surroundings clean.

Students should not remain absent from classes.

Any student who is absent in the class due to sickness, should inform the Warden and the Class Teacher.

Long leave on medical grounds may be availed only after obtaining the prior permission from the Principal. Medical Certificate should be submitted.

Staying back in the Hostel during the school hours without the permission is an offence.

If a student falls short of attendance as prescribed by the Board, he/she shall not be eligible for promotion to the next higher class.

No student is permitted to leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher.

All the Unit / Cycle Tests / Mid Term Tests and Examinations should be attended by the students.

Students should follow the timings of the School and the activity schedule in the hostel and on the playgrounds.

Every student must take part in the school's sports and games and extra-curricular activities.

Silence must be observed in the classrooms, study hall, dormitories, bathing rooms and Mess. Total silence must be observed in the campus between 10:00 pm and 5 am.

Discipline must be observed in the Dining hall, Library, Labs, Study halls, and games field. Any unruly behavior, unwanted arguments with the kitchen staff, warden, attenders, etc, will be dealt with seriously.

Silence should be observed in the bedroom. Students sitting and talking in groups on bed will be punished.

Disrespect to the authorities, teachers, wardens and dishonesty either inside or outside the premises will be dealt with seriously.

Students are forbidden from any money transactions amongst themselves.

Quarrels among the students are strictly prohibited.

No groupism is allowed and the same is punishable with immediate expulsion.

To Parents

Parents of the hostel students must bring their ward(s) to the hostel one day prior to the re-opening date after terminal holidays & festival holidays.

Parents desiring to nominate local guardians, should submit to the school office an authorization letter nominating the local guardian with sign and photo affixed on the letter.

Parents / Guardians are permitted to visit their ward(s) only once in a month and are not permitted to bring any eatables.

Parents/Guardians are not permitted to visit their ward(s) during the School hours.

Parents / Guardians are requested to follow the instructions given in the Student / Parent Hand Book and co-operate with the school for the betterment of their ward(s).

Visiting Hours

Parents can seek permission to meet or greet their ward(s) on important festival days or on Birthdays.

School authorities are responsible for the academic performance, all round development and other hostel related matters of the Children. Parents and guardians are requested not to disturb or visit their wards on any working day other than the stipulated days scheduled by the school.

Admissions are open for both boys and girls for classes from LKG to Std IX and Std XI.

The School authorities may modify and change the terms and conditions mentioned in the Prospectus, from time to time.


Parents may admit their ward(s) in PES School after thoroughly satisfying themselves by personally going around the Campus with our assistance & perusing the infrastructure.

Admission to all Classes is purely based on the performance in the Entrance Test.

Conditions for Withdrawal

Students once admitted will remain in the school for the entire course of study. Due to unavoidable circumstances, if parents wish to withdraw their child from school they will have to forfeit the entire amount of Annual Fee paid. However, if the reason for withdrawal is legitimate and is within a month from the date of admission, the Management may consider a refund. Parents have to inform in writing about the withdrawal and apply for the Transfer Certificate.
